



**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** John Wells

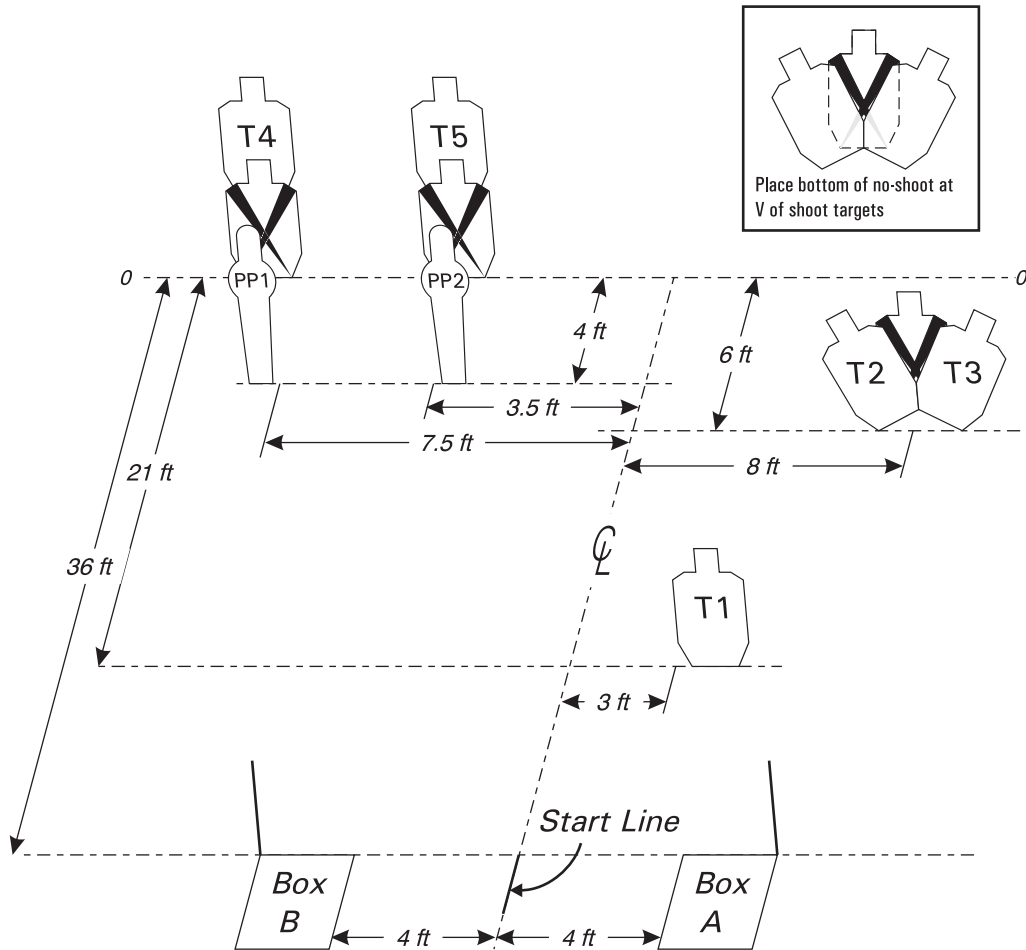
**START POSITION:** Standing facing appropriate post, both heels against start line, can with top cut out in strong hand.

### STAGE PROCEDURE

- String 1. Upon start signal, move to Box A and place can on post in corner of box with strong hand, then draw and from Box A engage only T1-T3.
- String 2. Upon start signal, move to Box B and place can on post in corner of box with strong hand, then draw and from Box B engage only PP1, PP2, T4, and T5.

### SCORING

- SCORING:** Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
- TARGETS:** 5 IPSC, 2 Pepper poppers
- SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper, KD = 1 A
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
  - Shooting while can not on post. -10
  - Shooting diagonally on wrong array. -10 each shot.
  - Touching gun before placing can on post. -10



**SETUP NOTES:** Set T1 and no-shoot at T2-T3 to 5 feet high at shoulder. T2 and T3 bottom edges butt together to form V across face of no-shoot. Place lower V-notch of shoot targets at bottom center of no-shoot. No-shoots are attached to T4 and T5 with top of no-



shoot at bottom of lower A zone on shoot target. Top of poppers are even with B-C line of no-shoots. Shooting boxes are 3 feet by 3 feet. Posts are 2-by-2s fastened to the inside corner of the shooting boxes. Use 10¾ oz. soup can with top cut out.
