START POSITION: Standing in shooting box facing targets with both arms hanging relaxed at sides.

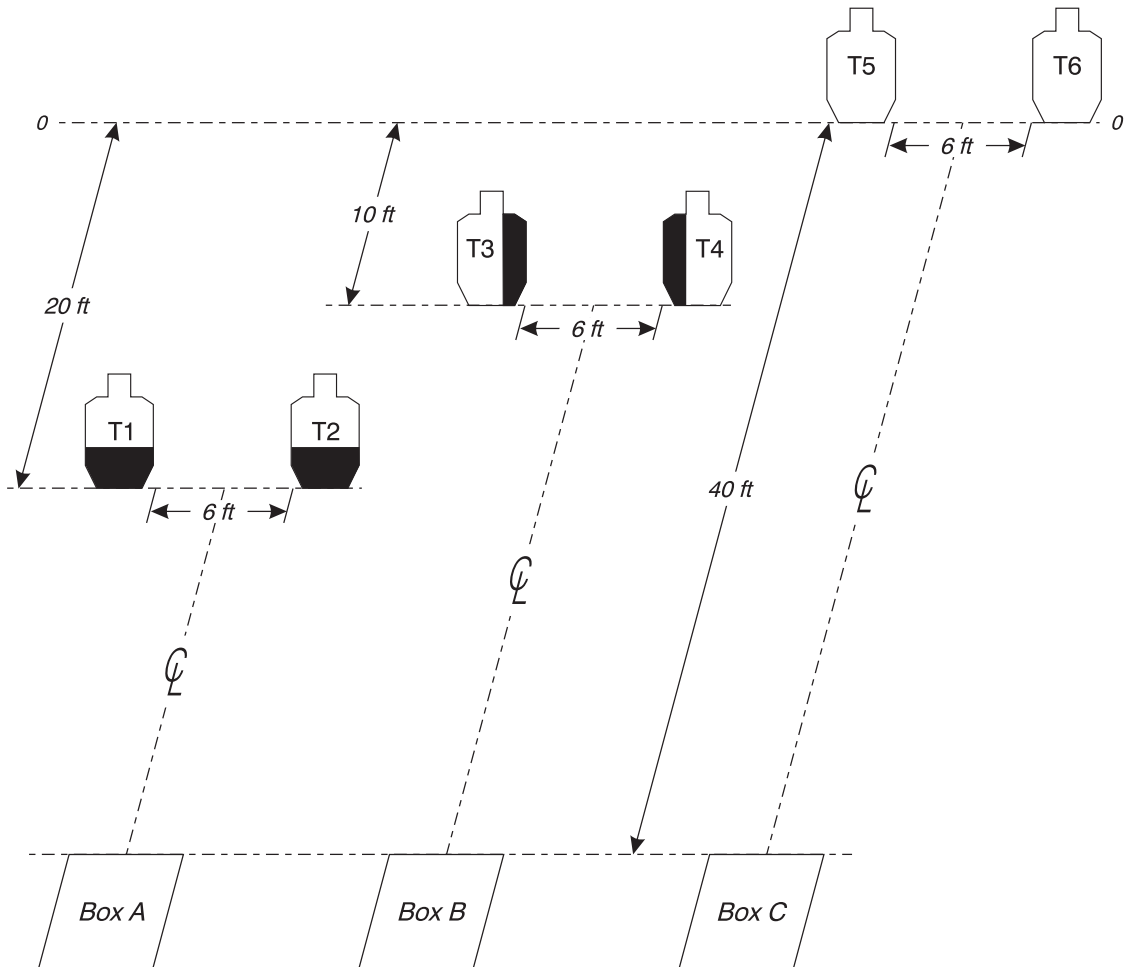
STAGE PROCEDURE

All Strings FREESTYLE

- String 1. Upon start signal, from Box A, engage only T1 and T2.
- String 2. Upon start signal, from Box B, engage only T3 and T4.
- String 3. Upon start signal, from Box C engage only T5 and T6.

SCORING

- SCORING:** Comstock, 12 rounds, 60 points
- TARGETS:** 6 IPSC
- SCORED HITS:** Best 2/paper
- START - STOP:** Audible - Last shot
- PENALTIES:** Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.



SETUP NOTES: Set paper targets to 5 feet high at shoulders. Target pairs are spaced 6 feet apart edge-to-edge. Hardcover on T1-T2 comes to bottom of A zone.



Hard cover on T3-T4 comes to edges of A zone. Space shooting boxes as close or as far apart as needed to fit your range. Boxes are 3 feet by 3 feet.
